

CAREER GUIDANCE POLICY

ELIGIBILITY:

1. All MBBS/BDS Students irrespective of the class, gender or academic qualification.
2. All House officers working in different departments of Medicare Cardiac & General Hospital and Sohail Trust Hospital

FREQUENCY OF SESSIONS:

- ✚ Annually for Final Year Students
- ✚ Annually for House Officers

PROCEDURE:

I. FACULTY DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES:

Faculty development activities may be carried out on site within the JMDC campus or MCGH & STH (Korangi).

The Department of Medical Education at Jinnah Medical and Dental College:
